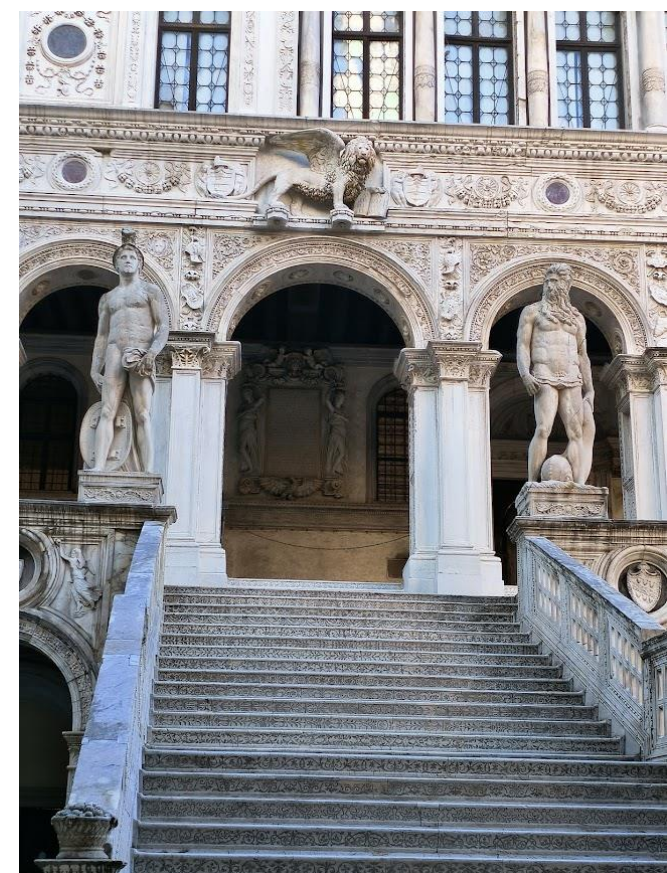

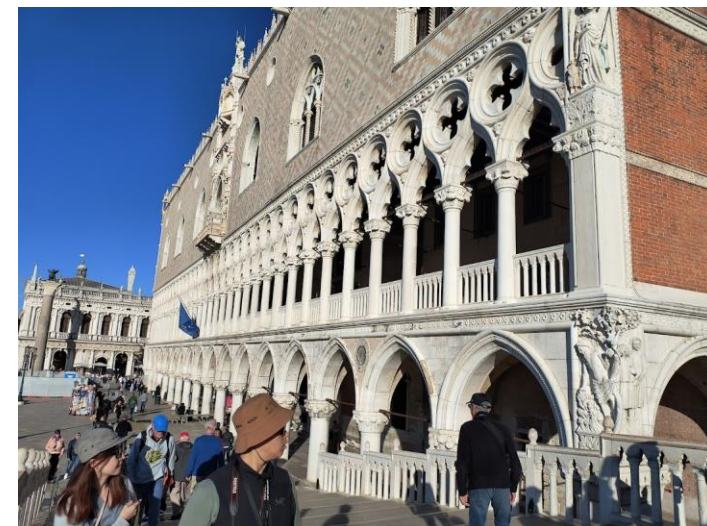


*S.S. La Venezia*

from our stateroom.

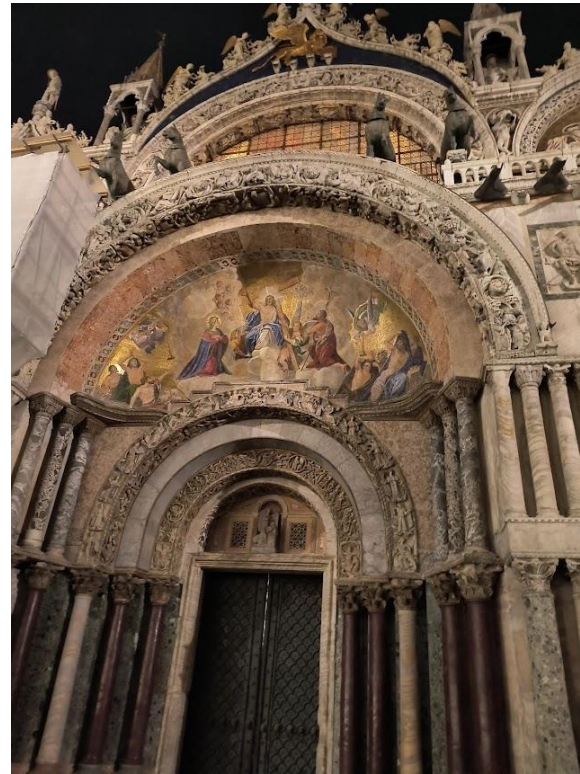
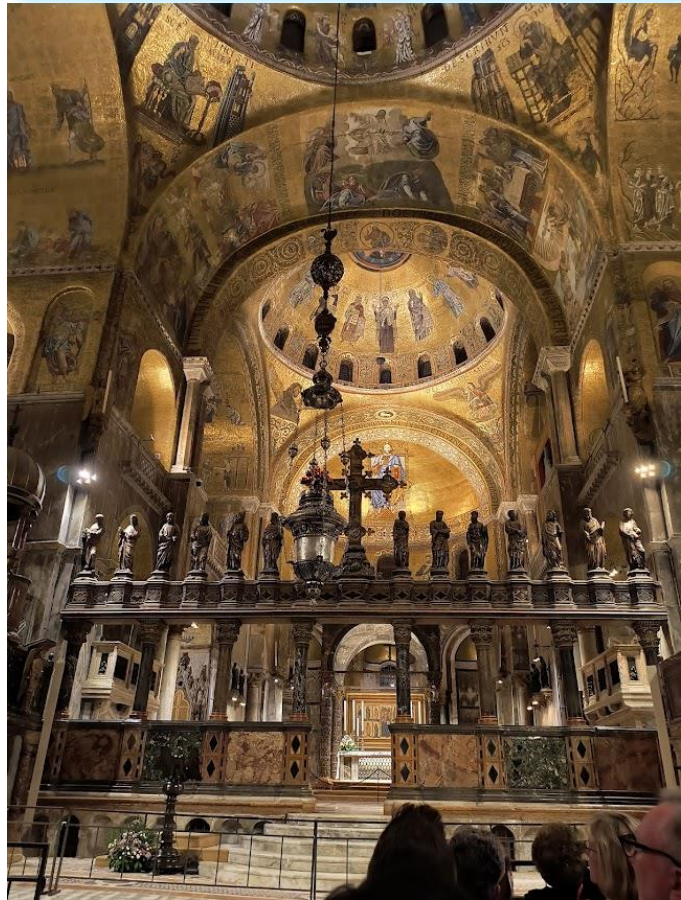


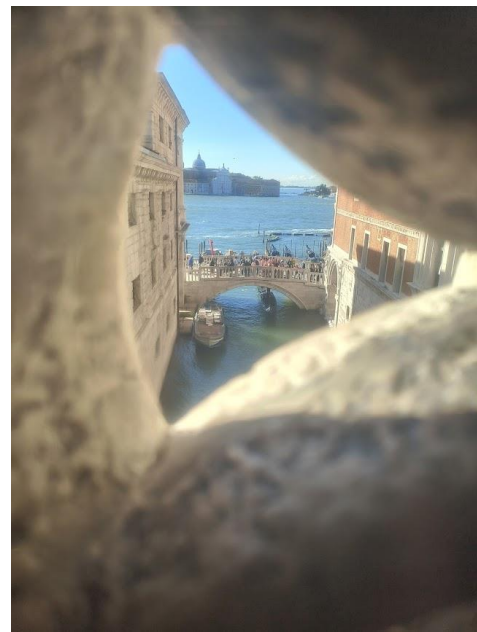
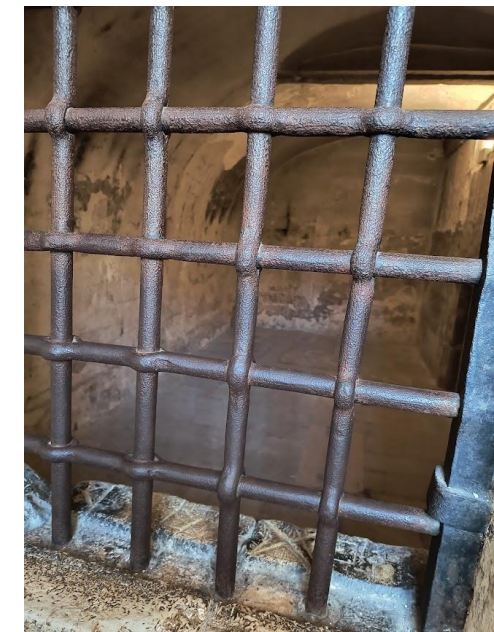


We did enter the city proper by foot and were treated to all the usual joys of Venice. But we also saw things we'd never seen before.

We also had a private tour of the Doge's Palace. The marvelous rooms, the dungeon and through the Bridge of Sighs.

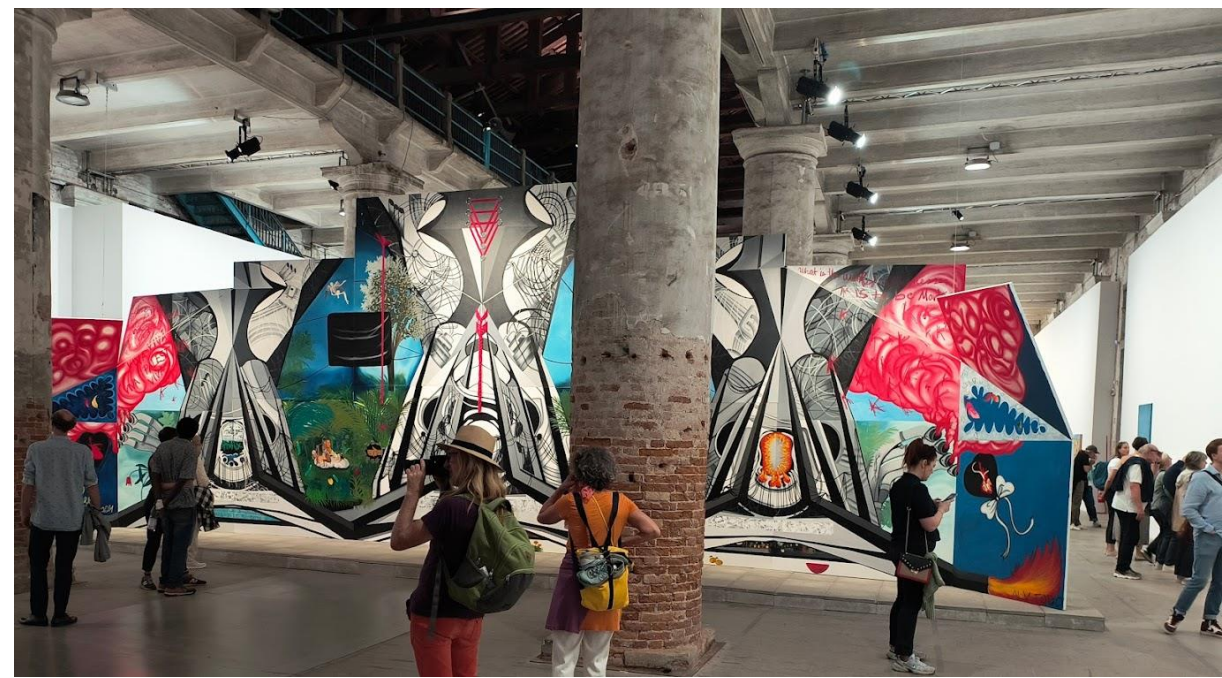


We visited other smaller islands, like Murano & Burano, where we lunched and had a glass-blowing exhibition.
